

## Funbikes

### Road:

1. *Plaine Joux*: Chamonix, Vaudagne, Servoz Plateau d'Assy (via Passy en Haut or La Motte) Plaine Joux. Return the same way. 2x33km, 1300m
2. *Emosson*: Chamonix, Col des Montets, Chatelard, Finhaut, Emosson Dam. Return the same way. 2x32km, 450+850+350m
3. *Flaine*: Roundabout Magland/Cluses, Les Carroz, Col de Pierre Carree. Return the same way. 2x23m, 1350m
4. *Col des Saisies*: Le Fayet, (roundabout with Crystal sculptures), Megeve, (top road), ND de Bellecombe, Col de Saisies. Two ways, return by the other. 2x45km, 1300m
5. *Bettex*: Le Fayet, (roundabout with Crystal sculptures), Bettex, St Nicholas en Verce, St Gervais, Le Fayet, (or in reverse.) 9+12km 900m (from Cham?)
6. *Col de Colombiere*: Cluses, Le Reposoir, Col de Colombiere. Return via Nancy en Cluses, (or link with 6). 21+24km, 1108m
7. *Col des Aravis*: Megeve, Flumet, La Giettaz, Col des Aravis. Return the same way (or link with 5 or 6). 2x33km, 550+200m
8. *Martigny*: Train to Martigny, (or cycle there!), Col de Forclaz, Col des Montets, Chamonix. 40km, 1050+350m
9. *Verbier*: Sembrancher, Le Chable, Verbier. Return the same way. 2x14km, 800m
10. *Col de Joux Plane*: Taninges, Samoens, D354, Col, Morzine Les Gets. (or return same way.) 2x12km, 1000m

### Road Tour:

*TMB*: Chamonix, Les Houches Le Fayet, Megeve, Col des Saisies, Beaufortain, [Cornet de Roselund](#), Les Chapieux, Bourg St Maurice, [Petit Bernard](#), Aosta, [Grand Bernard](#), Orsieres, Martigny, Col de Forclaz, Col des Montets, Chamonix. 330km, 8000m

### Trail:

1. *Les Houches – Contamines*: Bellevue Lift, Col de Voza, Les Bettieres, Le Champel, La Villette, Contamines, Diamant Vert track to St Gervais, Le Fayet. (Train back to Les Houches)
2. *Balcons North and South*: Chamonix, Petit Balcon du Sud (via Golf course to Argentiere), Return by Petit Balcon du Nord. Can be extended to La Tour or to Les Houches.
3. *Chatelard to Martigny*: Chatelard Frontiere, Finhaut, Route Diligence, Les Marcottes, Salvan, Les Vernayaz, Martigny. (Return by train, from Vernayaz to Finault, otherwise there is an 18CHF fee per bike!)
